In the second class we will dress the loom for a set of hand towels using the direct warping method with the warp and weft each doubled. Students will then finish weaving the towels on their own at home. Must already know the basics of how to warp a loom for this class. If bringing your own yarn you will need approximately 700 yards each of two highly contrasting colors in 8/2 unmercerized cotton. If not bringing your own yarn the materials fee is \$15.
