The application is available **January 30, 2024 with a March 15, 2024 deadline.** Two applicants selected will be notified on or by April 15th, 2024.

Applications are for the full two-week time period of the residency and participants must be 21 years of age or older. An Artist-in-Residency Advisory Board will review the applications, work samples, proposed residency projects, and the skill level of the candidates to determine their capacity to work independently.

An application fee of \$45.00 is required upon submitting your application. **Application fees are non-refundable.** Payment may be made by cash or check and dropped off at our shop gallery or mailed with a post-date prior to March 15th:
